Theme:

In 2<sup>nd</sup> grade the English class continues to work on and with songs, rhymes, movement, recitation and drama from 1<sup>st</sup> grade. The vocabulary expands with words from the child's own life and surroundings, including themselves, family, school, friends, colours, animals, food, clothes, time, and sport.
